1. When and Where:

The Alumni Reunion for the 2023 Governor's Scholars from the Centre College campus will be held at Centre College on **Wednesday**, **June 12**, **2024**. The following is a general outline of the day's activities. <u>Please note that all times *except* registration are tentative.</u> **ALL TIMES ARE EASTERN (EDT)**.

8:30 – 9:30 a.m.: Alumni arrive at Centre College Campus Centre

9:30 – 10:00 a.m.: Community Meeting in Weisiger

10:00 – 11:45 a.m.: GSP Leadership Seminar

12:15 p.m.: Lunch at Cowan Dining Hall 3:30 p.m.: Organized activities conclude.

2. **Registration Fee:**

The registration fee is \$30.00 per person if you make your reservation in advance of <u>June 1, 2024</u>. This fee covers the cost of lunch and the use of Centre College facilities. Please carefully read the registration form regarding deadlines and space availability.

3. What to Wear and What to Bring:

Dress as you did last summer—casual, comfortable, and tasteful. You may also want to bring any equipment you might need for impromptu recreational activities—Frisbee, volleyball, soccer, four square, etc.

4. **Food:**

The cost of a cafeteria lunch is included in your registration fee. Because this is a rare chance for the GSP-2023 community to reunite, we ask that after you have registered, you not leave the Centre College campus until the day's events have concluded. Please do not plan to leave campus for lunch or any snacks during the day.

6. **Directions and Parking Information:**

From Lexington (30 miles)

Take US 27 South. Turn right onto US 34 West. Continue through Danville on Lexington Avenue Turn left onto Maple Avenue Continue straight on Maple Avenue at the stop light. You have now entered Centre's campus. Turn left at the stop sign on to Walnut Street which will lead you straight to Norton Center. The parking lot is in the back of the building on the right.

From Louisville (85 miles)

Take I-64 East to Highway 151 South (Lawrenceburg-Graefenburg exit). Turn right at intersection onto US 127 South. Turn left onto US 127 Business (becomes Maple Avenue). Continue straight on Maple Avenue at the stop light. You have now entered Centre's campus. Turn left at the stop sign on to Walnut Street which will lead you straight to Norton Center. The parking lot is in the back of the building on the right.

From the southwest

Take I-65 North to Cumberland Parkway. Take the parkway east to US 127 (Russell Springs exit). Highway 127 North leads directly to Danville. Turn left onto US127 Bypass North. Continue straight on Maple Avenue at the stop light. You have now entered Centre's campus. Turn left at the stop sign on to Walnut Street which will lead you straight to Norton Center. The parking lot is in the back of the building on the right.

From the southeast

Take I-75 North to exit 62. Follow Route 25 South/461 South. Turn right onto US 150 West. Take US 150 West to Danville. Follow 150 West through Danville. Turn right onto Maple Avenue Continue straight on Maple Avenue at the stop light. You have now entered Centre's campus. Turn left at the stop sign on to Walnut Street which will lead you straight to Norton Center. The parking lot is in the back of the building on the right.

From the parking lot, walk to the front of the Norton Center, and then diagonally across the street to the Campus Center. Registration will take place in front of the Campus Center.
